Challenges

While V6 3.4 was suitable for its time, it had reached end of support and it was dated in terms of the functionality and user interface, notes Altus systems applications manager Sejal Patel.

The limitations which were becoming apparent in the older version included difficulties from the perspective of her team of developers, debugging was cumbersome and difficult, which meant it not only took time, but also caused frustrations," Sejal explains.

There were also growing issues with the customer experience in their fabricators.

Solution

Altus partnered with Soft Tech to develop an upgrade pathway to move on to the latest version of V6 3.7 software.

Over the course of five months, Altus upgraded its V6 deployment and is today seeing the benefits of advances in software performance for its developers and customers alike.

Results

The Altus upgrade to Soft Tech V6 3.7 has general benefits which Sejal describes as 'making work easier and faster'.

From a programming perspective, Sejal says her developers are particularly appreciative of the improved way in which macros are handled in 3.7. "With the updated version, we can search for products within the macro and it gives a list of all products contained therein; then, we can see and change the code directly instead of opening the macro, searching for the specific item, and then only changing it."

For Altus' customers, the improved user interface in V6 3.7 contributes to a better experience every day. "Today, a great user interface is expected by users and, of course, substantial advances have been made in the way modern systems work," says Sejal. "Our customers find things far easier because, for example, they can see extrusion profiles in the Bill of Materials. In the past, this was a part number which was hard to remember. Now, when hovering on a part number it shows an image – and that means fewer mistakes and faster working, as it is far easier to recognise a picture rather than a number."

Finally, for an organisation working with multiple fabricators, Sejal says details like the ability to allow fabricators to customise their own experience in V6 is useful. "Our fabricators are now able to add their own logo and company details into their V6 for quoting and orders."

"Another point is that the upgrade was quite simple, particularly as we involved Soft Tech to plan and manage any errors. They proved very responsive, and I have to credit my team, too, who after the upgrade went through every formula and macro to verify them."
